



Mounting instructions for the Monarch Pass Saddle Bags #M321 to “OTHER BRANDS” of side racks  
(i.e. Touratech, Happy Trails, Hepco Becker or Givi for example)

Thank you for purchasing the Monarch Pass Saddle Bags

**\*\*READ THOROUGHLY BEFORE ATTACHING TO OTHER RACKS\*\***

\*For best results take a test ride before putting your Monarch Saddle Bags to use\*

\*Helpful hint: Before you begin stuff each bag with a sleeping bag or quilt to give it body\*

\*The mounting is the same for both left and right bags\*

**MAXIMUM WEIGHT LIMIT: 13lbs (5.9 kg) per bag.**

\*Please note the various parts of the Monarch Saddle Bag. Since left and right are identical one is shown. Fig.2



## Mounting the D-Ring straps to the rack

There are 4 D-Ring straps per rack per side you will install. They will look like this. Fig.3

1- Place the D-Ring strap with the loop/fuzzy side out, and the hook/grippy side facing the rack tube. Fig.4

2- Thread the D-Ring strap around the rack tube, and then through the D-Ring. Wrap very tight. The loop/fuzzy side will stick to the hook/grippy side. Wrap until you use the entire strap. Sequence: Fig.5 & Fig.6

3-Repeat this for the remaining D-Ring straps. (4 per side rack)

**\*\*Please note the four D-Ring straps you mounted in steps 1-3 around the perimeter of the hoop. Since the left and right hoops are the same only one is shown. Fig.7**

## Mounting Monarch Pass Saddle Bags to “OTHER” side racks

1- Loosen all eight side mounting straps (four on each bag).

2- Place the bags over the seat and rear of bike. A properly adjusted set of Monarch Pass Saddle Bags. Fig.8

3- Insert the chrome slide on the side mounting straps into the D-Rings on the rack (4 per bag). Fig.5

\*\*Side view of bag attached to the D-Ring straps and rack. Fig.6

4- Start with the side mounting straps front and rear. Turn and insert the chrome slide, at the end of the webbing, through the D-ring at the bottom of the rack. Pull webbing so the chrome slide catches and cannot slip through the D-Ring. Fig.12 & Fig.13

5- Repeat this operation for all the D-rings top and bottom and on the other side rack.

6- Adjust the hook and loop seat straps so the bags sit almost level with the seat. Fig. 8

7-Adjust the seat straps at the black metal slides on the bags. Fig.14

Fine tune with the seat straps: Remember to keep as much of the hook and loop on the seat straps connected as possible.

7- Tighten the side mounting straps Snug. Thread excess webbing through strap keeper. Fig.15

8- Make sure ALL straps are snug and the bags are secure. Make adjustments as necessary.

**To remove the Monarch Pass Saddle Bags**

You can remove the bags as a pair or individually.

9-Loosen all the side mounting straps (4per bag).

10-Pass the chrome slides back through the D-rings on the "Other" Side racks to free straps. (Reverse steps 3 and 4)

11- Lift bags off. If you want to take them off separately separate the 2" hook and loop seat straps.

**Helpful hints**

The Monarch Pass Saddle Bags have 1 and 2 inch D-Rings incorporated into the bags. Fig.2

These are for attaching additional Wolfman products, like a small or medium Rolie Bag (Fig.16) or our Bottle Holster (Fig.17) for additional fuel or water.
