

## FITTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR CP0147BK CRASH PROTECTORS TRIUMPH SPRINT ST '05







Please note that the way the kit is packed does not necessarily represent the way of mounting to the bike

Please note that in cases where kits are packed with rubber washers holding the components onto the bolt – the rubber washers should be thrown away!

## OFF SIDE (RIGHT SIDE AS YOU SIT ON BIKE)

- Remove RHS fairing
- Remove front engine bolt
- Remove rear engine bolt
- Take the long bar with the 2 tapped holes closest together and slide up behind the electrics curved end towards the rear and bar to the top
- Take 1 of the longest bolts slide washer over bolt
- Take 1 of the 15mm long spacers and fit between bar and frame sliding the bolt through the bar spacer and frame (rear engine mount)
- Using the oem nut do up finger tight
- Take 1 of the 110mm long cap head bolts and slide washer over bolt
- Take 1 of the 15mm long spacers and fit between bar and frame sliding the bolt through the bar spacer and frame (front engine mount)
- Using the oem nut tighten fully
- Tighten the rear nut fully
- Take the l shaped block and fit to the bar using the 2 m10x50 cap head bolts with washers under the heads note the tapped hole points down and tighten
- Refit fairing
- Take 1 of m10x100 lg hex head bolts and slide washer up to head put bolt through 1 of the bobbins with a neck then slide through spacer 24mm diax24mm long and tighten into 1 shaped block
- Take 1 of the m12 x100mm lg hex head bolts and slide washer up to head put bolt through 1 of the bobbins without neck and tighten to bar using tapped hole to the rear of the fairing
- Repeat for lhs except curved end faces forward with the bar at the bottom
- The 15mm long spacer goes between frame and bar at the front
- The 21mm long spacer goes between frame and bar at the rear

These terms do not affect the Buyer's statutory rights.

## R&G RACING RETURNS POLICY (NON-FAULTY GOODS)

Returns must be pre-authorised (if not pre-authorised the return will be rejected)

Goods may only be returned direct to us if they were purchased direct from us (customer must prove if necessary). Otherwise to be returned to original vendor.

Goods must be in re-sellable condition, in the opinion of R&G Racing.

All returns are subject to a 25% restocking and handling fee (25% of the gross value exc. P&P – at the prevailing price at time of purchase).

The customer must pay any and all carriage charges.

No returns of discontinued products, unless within 14 days of purchase.

This policy does not affect your statutory rights and does not refer to faulty goods.
