STEP 1 Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition.




BIKE PREP:


Carefully remove the amber fork reflectors from both forks. They will not be reused. Slide both of the OEM fork deflectors up (1), then gently pull them off the forks (2). PIC 1 Set them aside; they will not be reused.

ASSEMBLE THE MOUNTING HARDWARE:

- STEP 3 Carefully slide one of the included O-rings over one of the Centering Bungs. PIC 2 Ensure the O-ring locates in the groove in the Bung. Repeat for the other Bung.
- Lube the O-ring with a shot of glass cleaner, then insert the Centering Bungs into the recessed screw holes in the bottom of the forks as shown in PIC 3. Ensure the O-rings stay in the grooves and push the Bungs in until they contact the bottom of the forks.










- Put one of the included Flat Washers over one of the M5 screws. PIC 4 Repeat for the other screws. Set the screws within arms reach of the work area.
- STEP 6 Insert one of the included Set Screws into the bottom of both of the Lower Fork Covers. Thread the Set Screw into the cover until it is just below the surface of the weldnut. PIC 5

STEP 7 Determine the clutch-side (left) and brake-side (right) Fork Deflectors and Lower Fork Covers. PIC 6

STEP 8 Clip the clutch-side Fork Deflector over the lower fork tube (1). Spin it clockwise until the screw holes are facing the outside (2), then slide the Deflector down (3) as shown in PIC 7.

STEP 9 Position the clutch-side (left) Lower Fork Cover over the lower portion of the fork. PIC 8

STEP 10 Secure the Lower Fork Cover to the Fork Deflector with two of the screws from STEP 5. Leave the screws snug for now.

Turn the Set Screw (in the bottom of the Fork Cover) clockwise until it contacts the Centering Bung. While turning the Set Screw, push in on the bottom of the cover until you feel the Set Screw "center" in the Bung. Leave the Set Screw snug for now.

NOTE: Ensure that the ABS sensor wires are free and clear of the clutch-side Fork Cover. Loosen the two top screws and gently "twist" the Fork Cover to achieve proper clearance between the fender and fork cover. Re-tighten the screws.

STEP 12 Ensure that there is clearance between any moving and stationary parts, then tighten the two screws from STEP 10. PIC 8

STEP 13 Tighten the Set Screw from **STEP 11**.


STEP 14 Repeat **STEPS 8 through 13** for the brake-side (right).


STEP 15

Ensure that all fasteners are tight and that the Covers and Deflectors will not interfere with the proper operation of the motorcycle **BEFORE** riding. Roll the bike and compress the front suspension to confirm clearance of all moving parts.

NOTICE

It is the end user's responsibility to ensure that all of the fasteners (including pre-assembled) are tightened before operation of the motorcycle. Küryakyn will not provide warranty coverage on products or components lost due to improper installation or lack of maintenance.
