



MOUNTING SUGGESTIONS:

**2014 Indian Chieftain,
Chief Vintage & Chief Classic**
Wide Touring Solo with Driver Backrest &
Passenger Seat with Passenger Backrest

Hardware included: White nylon washer
2 – 1/4" x 5/8"-20 screws

Tools needed: 5 mm Allen wrench
6 mm Allen wrench
Phillips screwdriver

Removal of Stock Seat:

1. Remove the 8mm screw from the rear bracket using a 5mm Allen wrench. (Fig. 1)
2. Remove the right and left side covers by pulling straight back, releasing the studs from the rubber grommets (There are three grommets holding each cover). (Fig. 2)
3. Using a 6mm Allen wrench, remove the screws from the side brackets on both the right and left side of the seat. (Fig. 3)
4. Lift the rear of the seat and pull away from the tank to remove the stock seat.
