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




NOTE: If you also purchased AltRider crash bars install them first, reference crash bar instructions and take note that step #1 is critical. If you already have AltRider crash bars installed skip to step #3. Place bike on center stand. Remove OEM skid plate and any brackets. Using a T50 Torx driver remove the (2) OEM engine bolts from each side, keep them.


TIP:




Place the bike on its side stand. Using your hand compress the rear brake caliper so you can freely move the rear brake lever down.



(IF YOU ARE INSTALLING SKID PLATE ON ADVENTURE MODEL, REFER TO SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS **INCLUDED WITH ADVENTURE BRACKETS)** Starting with the right side install the brackets with spacer, M8 bolt and washer (a), and (2) OEM M10 Torx bolts (b). Use anti-seize. Get all fasteners started but do not tighten yet. Repeat on the left side. See diagram above for reference. TIP: take your time getting the frame aligned with holes in engine mounts. Note: If the holes are not aligned you can leverage on the frame to align holes.




One side at a time and starting on the right side, remove the snap ring (a), and oem center stand pin by pushing inward with extension or with 13mm socket (b). Lube and replace with the provided AltRider center stand pin and replace OEM snap clip (c). Repeat for left side.



Align the front of the skid plate with the front brackets and using an M6 driver install all (4) M8 socket head cap bolts and M8 washers. Use thread locker. Leave all (4) loose for now.



Ride for 100 - 500 miles and check inspect all fasteners for correct torque rating. Also inspect the snap rings to ensure they are holding in the groove of the center stand pins.



With bike still on side stand. Start installing the skid plate rear right mount first. Start the M8 hex head bolt and washer on the rear right side mount. You can hold the bolt in place while you spin the center stand pin with an M6 allen driver to help get it started. On the left side, install the M8 flat head screw in the same manner but using a M5 allen driver to hold the bolt in place. Use thread locker on both bolts. Tighten each M8 bolt to 10nm of torque. Hold the pins in place with the M6 allen and torque the bolts only. DO NOT TORQUE PINS. Return to bracket bolts listed in step #2 and torque the M8's to 13nm and the M10's to 55nm. Finally finish up by tightening all (4) front mount M8 bolts (from step #5) to 13 nm of torque.
