
DIY WINDSCREEN INSTALL

### Installation Instructions for 2011 Suzuki GSX1250FA & 2008-2010 GSX650F

Thank you for purchasing a Zero Gravity windscreen, which has been designed and manufactured to give you years of safe & fun riding. These instructions will give you an in-depth look at the installation process. To receive further assistance or parts please e-mail techinfo@zerogravity-racing.com.

#### PLEASE READ BEFORE MOUNTING YOUR WINDSCREEN

#### Helpful hints: Use metric tools, clean hands, put the bike on a stand. To avoid damage do not pry on the screen excessively.



**Fig 1.** Before starting disassembly, please review this instruction sheet to better understand the install / uninstall process. The installation of Zero Gravity screen is in reverse.



**Fig 2.** Remove both mirrors. Be careful not to drop the mirrors! Remove Phillips head screw that's holding the windscreen, remove wellnuts by pulling them out. **See FIG2.** 





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#### Fig 4.

Looking from the upper inside fairing. Remove total of 4 screws, and take note of the different thread pitches. **(For Both Sides)** 



Fig 6. Remove 2 allen fastener closest to the tank. (For Both Sides) See FIG6. Note: The finish allen screws are in black.



Fig 5. On the same plastic fairing, remove 2 black short allen fastener located on the bottom of the instrument cluster. (For Both Sides) See FIG5. Note: The finish allen screws are in Black.




Fig 6A. On the same plastic fairing, there are 4 silver allen fastener located on the top and the sides. (For Both Sides) Note: The finish allen screws are in Silver.






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**Fig 7.** Remove instrument panel by pulling it apart from the fairing frame. The wire harness needs to be disconnected before fully removing. **USE CAUTION TO NOT OVER PULL!!!** 



**Fig 8.** Now you are ready to separate the inner fairing from the bike. Start from the two tail ends and start dislodging and working your way to the inside.



Fig 9. Remove 2 allen fastener at the bottom windscreen, viewing from the inside fairing. (For Both Sides) See FIG9.



Fig 9A. After removing both allen fastener, remove the wellnut for easier screen removal. (For Both Sides) See FIG9A.





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


Fig 10. Remove all 4 phillips screw, located behind the inner fairing. See FIG10.



Fig 11. Prepare to remove windscreen. Hold the windscreen top and bottom as shown. First lift bottom of windscreen up towards you. While pulling top of screen towards the bike tank. See FIG11. Be careful not to exert too much force!



Fig 12. To Install Windscreen. Replace windscreen in reverse steps.
