



MOUNTING SUGGESTIONS:

Honda Fury 2010-2017 Solo Seat

Hardware:	$\frac{1}{4}$ " chrome washer x 2 White nylon washer x 2 6mm x 15mm Allen screw x 2
Tools needed:	Metric Allen wrenches

Removal of Stock Seat:

1. Locate and remove the two Allen screws from the sides of the passenger seat.
2. Pull up seat cover at rear of the passenger seat to expose the rear Allen screw and remove. Lift passenger seat back and up to remove from motorcycle.
3. Pull up seat cover on the rear sides of the solo to expose two more mounting screws and remove. Lift solo seat up and back to remove from motorcycle.



Installation of Mustang Seat:

Note: See passenger seat instructions for mounting with a Mustang passenger seat.

Solo alone:

1. Insert the solo's front bracket into the frame receptacle behind the fuel tank above the shock mount.



2. Position white nylon washers between the seat brackets and the fender. Secure the rear brackets to the fender with the supplied chrome washers and 6mm screws.

Solo with stock rear:

1. Remove the rear bracket from the stock seat by unscrewing the two Allen screws.



2. Insert the solo's front bracket into the frame receptacle behind the fuel tank above the shock mount.



3. Position the stock bracket under the solo's mounting brackets and secure the seat and bracket to the fender with the stock screws.

4. Position the stock rear onto the fender and re-install the side and rear screws.

Enjoy the comfort and custom look of your new Mustang seat!
