

Workshop installation instructions

Guards for front axle



Before commencing work, you must read these installation instructions through carefully and make sure you understand them fully.

BMW Motorrad recommends having this installation kit installed by a specialist workshop with the requisite special tools, preferably an authorised BMW Motorrad dealer.

Incorrect installation and incorrect handling give rise to considerable safety risks.

Tightening torque

General instructions

ATTENTION

Vehicle is not securely propped.

Risk of damage to parts if vehicle topples.


► Installing end stoppers for front axle

NOTICE


It is absolutely essential to install the caps correctly positioned (BMW logo horizontal), because removal without damaging the caps is **not possible**.

Installing left front end stopper

- Insert end stopper (1) (small diameter) fully into front axle (2) (if necessary, back off clamping screw (3) slightly prior to insertion).
- Tighten clamping screw (3).



• Install cap (4).



Installing right front end stopper

- Insert end stopper (1) (large diameter) fully into front axle (2) (if necessary, back off clamping screw (3) slightly prior to insertion).
- Tighten clamping screw (3).

End stopper in front axle, right	
M8 x 60	24 Nm

► Final check of work performed

- · Check that
- the work as performed achieved the intended purpose.
- all reservoirs and containers have been filled and that all fluids and lubricants are at their correct levels.

- all threaded fasteners released beforehand have been correctly retightened.
- the fuel system is free of leaks.
- the lights and signalling equipment are fully operational and that the motorcycle is roadworthy.
- the brake pads of the front and rear brakes are bedded against the brake discs.

▶ Function test, engine start suppression

Check

- Move the kill switch to the operating position (ON).
- · Select neutral.
- Switch on the ignition.
- » Neutral telltale light "N" lights up.
- · Select a gear.
- » Neutral telltale light "N" goes out.
- Press the starter button.
- » Starter does **not** operate.
- Extend the side stand.
- Pull the clutch lever.
- Press the starter button.
- » Starter does **not** operate.
- Retract the side stand.
- Press the starter button without releasing the clutch lever.
- » Starter operates.

Result

Not all test steps completed successfully.

Measure

Check the appropriate parts with the BMW Motorrad diagnostic system.
