EE Radiator Guards Installation Instructions

Note: Installation of this product requires the use of Enduro Engineering 11-150 radiator braces.

- Remove seat, gas tank, radiator shrouds, and plastic louvers
- Drain radiator coolant, by removing the radiator cap and then the coolant drain plug on the side of the water pump (Fig 1)
- Reinstall coolant drain plug
- Loosen the hose clamps on the top and bottom of the radiators, then pull the hoses off the radiators (Fig 2)
- Remove the 4 or 6 bolts holding the radiators to the frame
- Using the supplied 6x16mm button head bolts attach one side of the radiator guard to the corresponding (R or L) big piece of the 11-150 Radiator Brace. (Fig. 3)
- 7 Slide this assembly over the radiator as shown. (Fig. 4)
- Connect the corresponding small radiator brace piece to the guard assembly using the supplied 6x16mm and 6x8mm button head bolts. (Fig. 5)
- Reconnect the radiator and Brace/Guard assembly to the frame using the supplied 6x30mm hex head bolts and 22mm washers. (Fig. 6)
- 9 Repeat steps 2-4 on the opposite side of the bike.
- Connect all radiator hoses and tighten clamps.

- Add coolant.
- 12 Attach the gas tank and shrouds.
- Attach the provided 6mm clip nut on the lower radiator shroud mount. (Fig. 7)
- Use the provided 6x25mm hex head bolts and the nylon spacer at the lower shroud mount (spacer between the shroud and radiator). (Fig. 8)
- Reinstall the seat.
- Ride safe and have fun!
