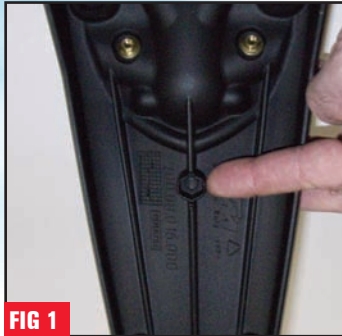

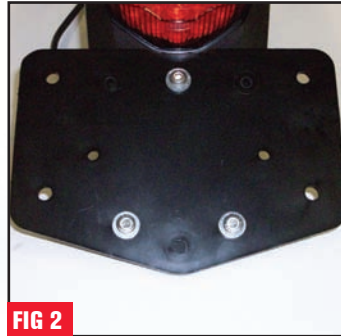

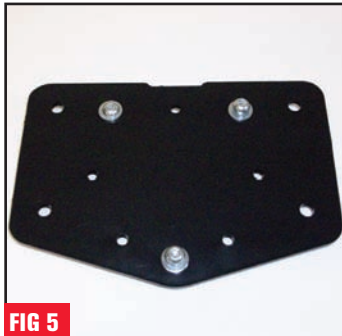

08 – 09 KTM Spare Part Rear Mud Guard

- 1 Drill a 1/4" hole in the sub fender from the underside in the location shown in figure 1.
- 2 Mount the license plate holder onto the sub fender with the "V" side down using 3 of the supplied 6x20mm button head mounting bolts with 3 of the supplied flat washers as shown in Figure 2.
- 3 Insert the supplied 6mm self locking nuts in the molded portion of the underside of the sub fender as shown in Figure 3.
- 4 Using a 4mm Allen wrench or t-handle, tighten all 3 mounting bolts.
- 5 Use the 4 supplied 6x16mm button head bolts, washers and 6mm lock nuts to mount license plate to holder.

04 – 06 KTM EXC Models

- 1 Using a 1/4" drill bit, drill 3 holes thru the dimples (Figure 4) in the underside of the sub fender.
- 2 Insert 3 of the supplied 6x20mm button head mounting bolts with flat washers on the license plate holder as shown in figure 5.
- 3 Mount the license plate holder with the "V" side down onto the sub fender using the 3 holes you just drilled.
- 4 Place one of the supplied flat washers and one of the supplied 6mm lock nuts on the back side of each mounting bolt.
- 5 Using a 4mm Allen wrench or t-handle and a 10mm box end wrench to hold the lock nut, tighten each of the mounting bolts.
- 6 Use the 4 supplied 6x16mm button head bolts, washers and 6mm lock nuts to mount license plate to holder.

07 – 09 KTM EXC Models

- 1 Remove the two bolts that hold the aluminum reflector bracket on. Figure 6
- 2 Insert 4 of the supplied 6x20mm button head mounting bolts with flat washers through the license plate holder as shown in figure 7
- 3 Mount license plate holder with the "V" side down using the existing top mounting holes (figure 8) and the reflector bracket mounting holes.
- 4 Place one of the supplied lock nuts on the back side of the top mounting bolts. The bottom mounting bolts should already have lock nuts in them for the reflector bracket. (If not, use 2 of the supplied lock nuts)
- 5 Using a 4mm Allen wrench or t-handle and a 10mm socket to hold the lock nut, tighten each of the mounting bolts.
- 6 Use the 4 supplied 6x16mm button head bolts, washers and 6mm lock nuts to mount license plate to holder.

ALL OTHERS MODELS: Use existing mounting holes if possible. If not, drill holes as needed and use supplied mounting hardware.
