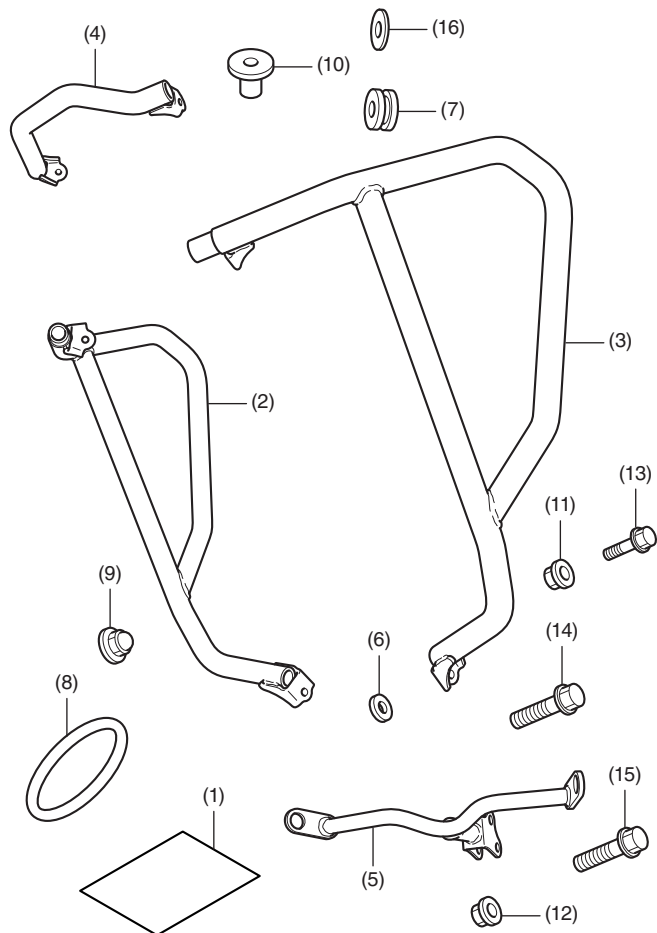

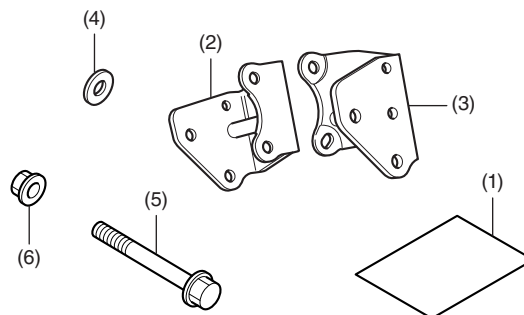

TORQUE CHART

Tighten all screws, bolts, and nuts to their specified torque values. Refer to the Service Manual for the torque values of the removed parts.

6 mm flange nut	12	1.2	9

▲CAUTION

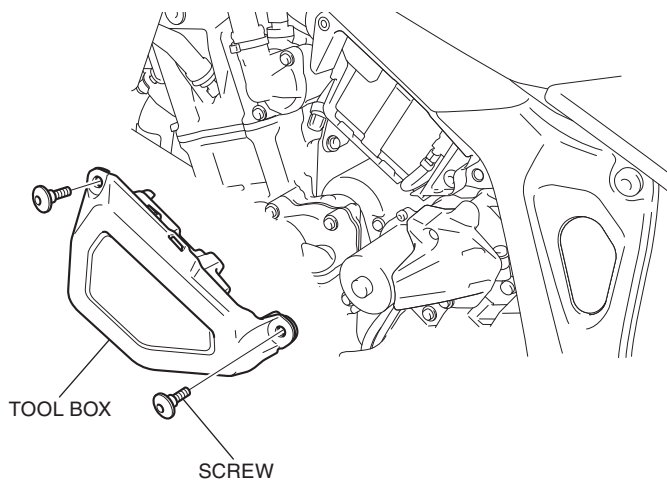
- To prevent burns, allow the engine, exhaust system, radiator, etc., to cool before installing the accessory.

NOTE:

- Refer to this manual and the Engine guard Installation Instructions when the motorcycle is equipped with the Engine guard.
- Disconnect the negative (-) cable from the battery before installing this accessory.
- The memory of the clock will be erased when you disconnect the battery. Reset the clock after reconnecting the battery.
- Reinstall the removed parts on the motorcycle and make sure that the wires and harnesses are not pinched.
- Although the illustration is of CRF1100D4, use the same procedures for the CRF1100A4 model.

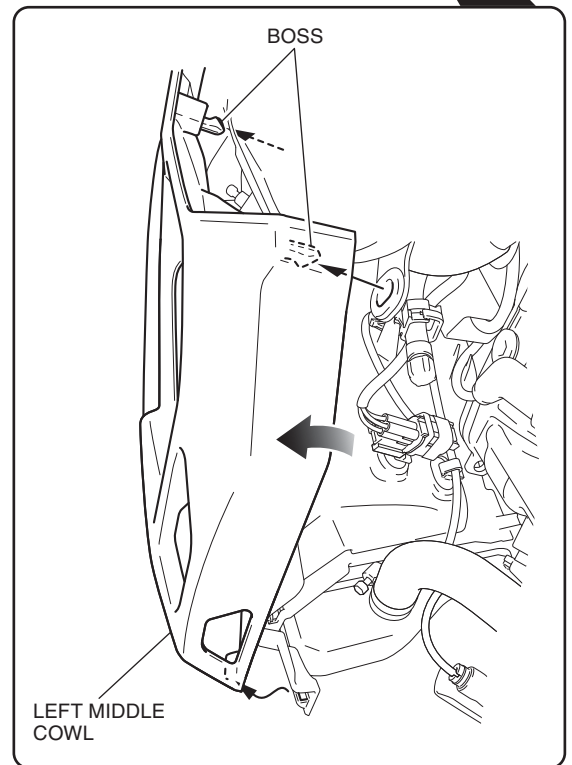
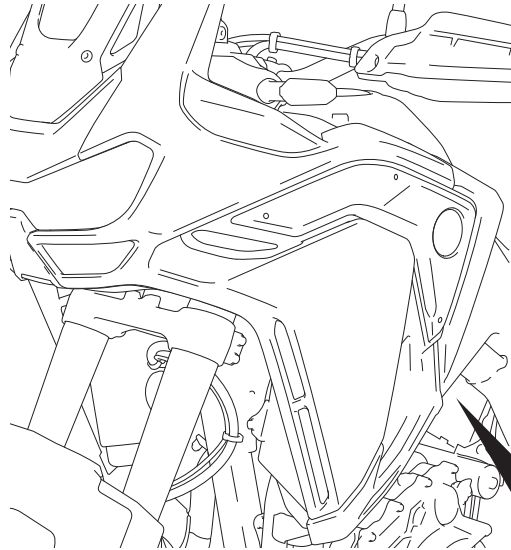
1. Remove the tool box and disconnect the negative (-) cable of the battery.

<Left side>

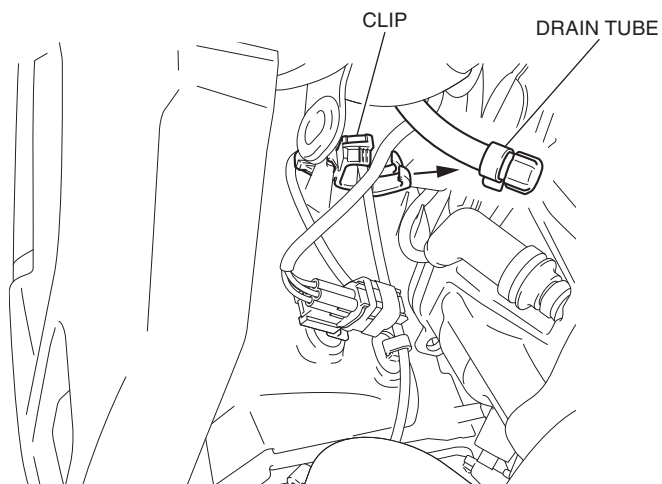


2. Remove the bosses of the left middle cowl as shown.

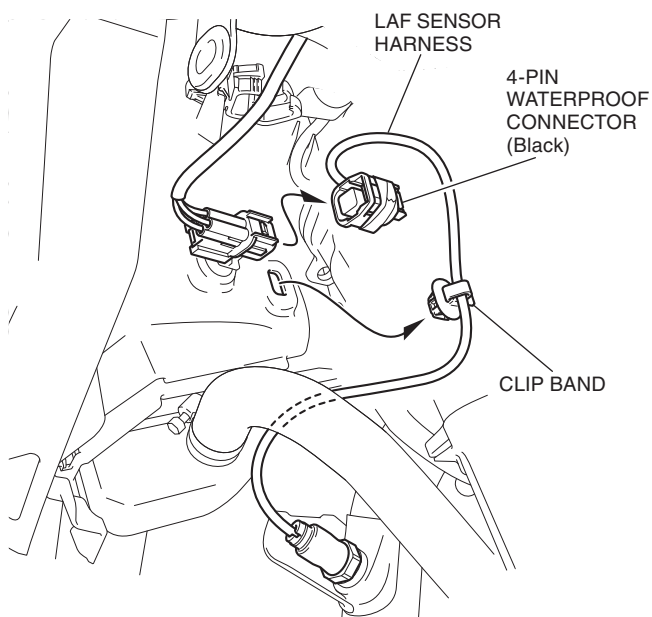
<Left side>



3. Remove the drain tube as shown.



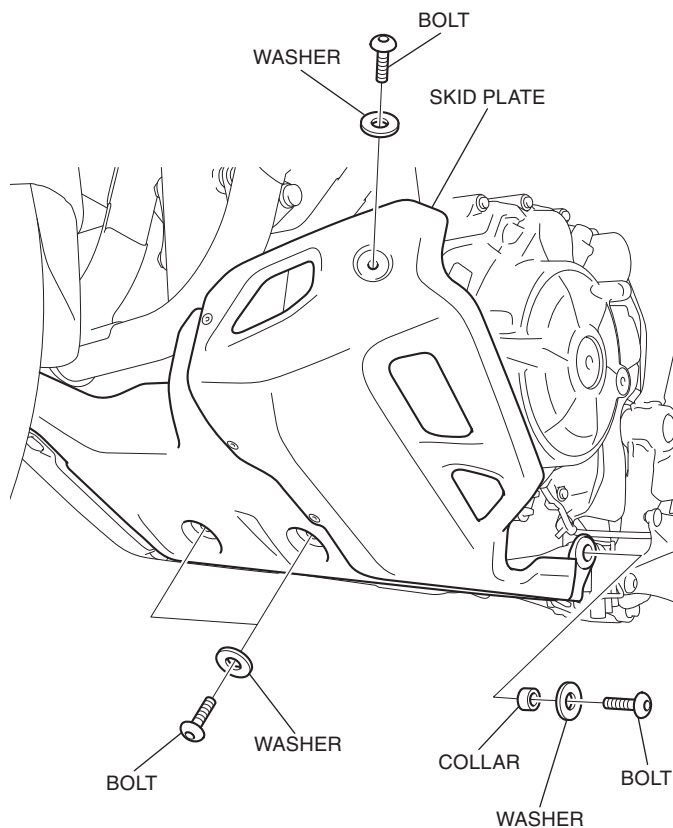
4. Remove the harness as shown.



5. Remove the bosses of the right middle cowl, drain tube and LAF sensor harness in the same manner as the left side.

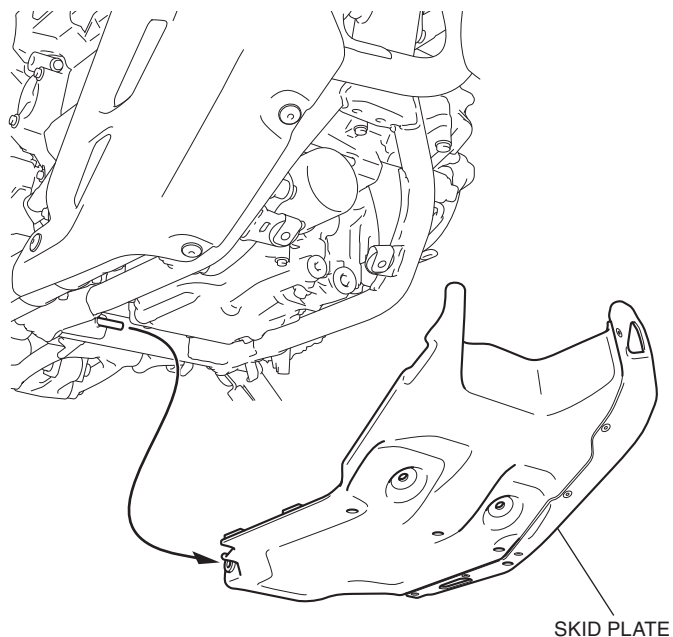
6. Remove the parts as shown.

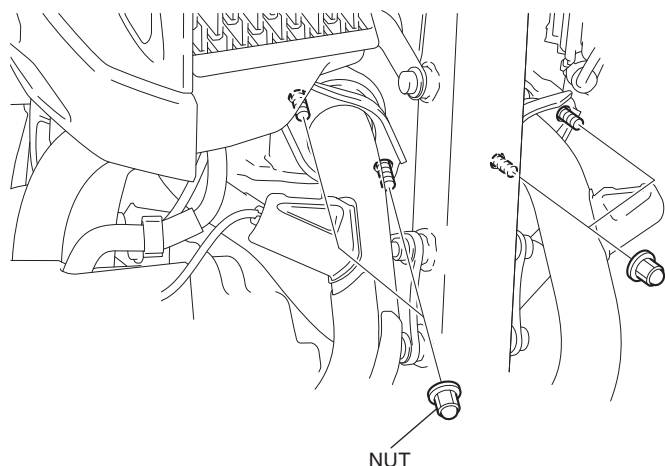


7. Remove the skid plate as shown.

<Right side>

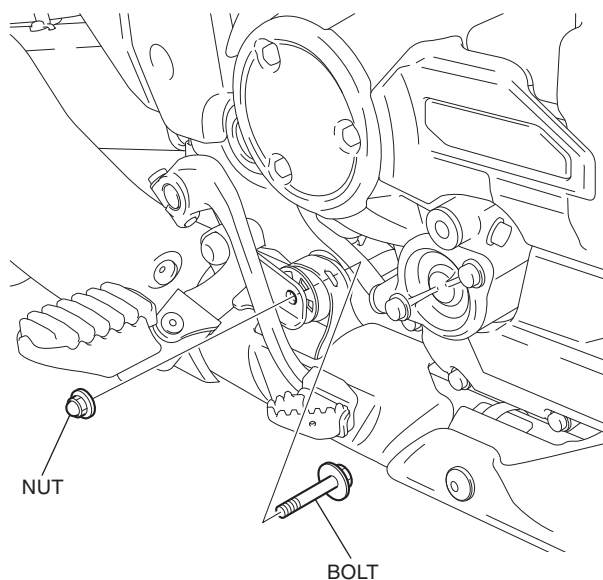


8. Remove the nuts as shown.

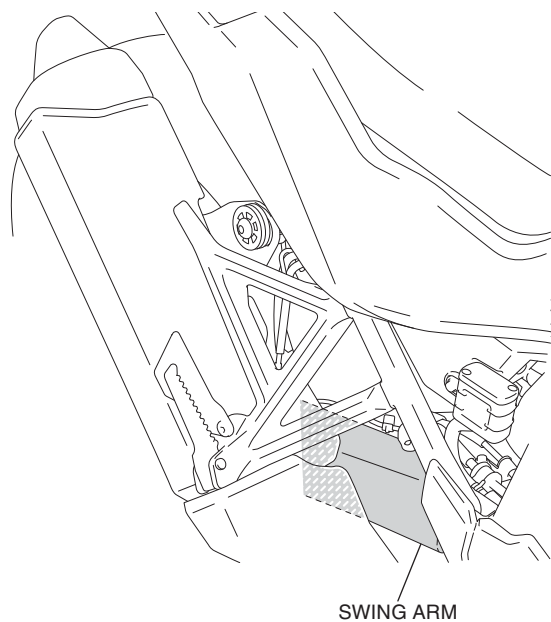


9. Remove the parts as shown.

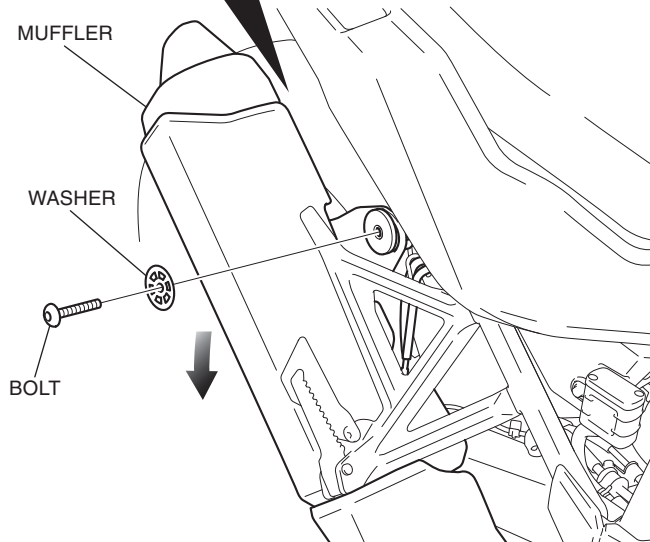
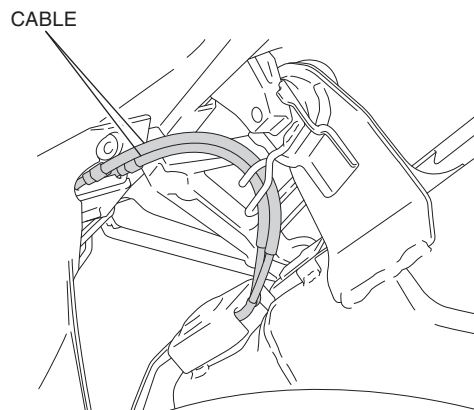
10. Protect the swing arm with a shop towel or similar.



11. Remove the bolt, and then lower the muffler as shown.

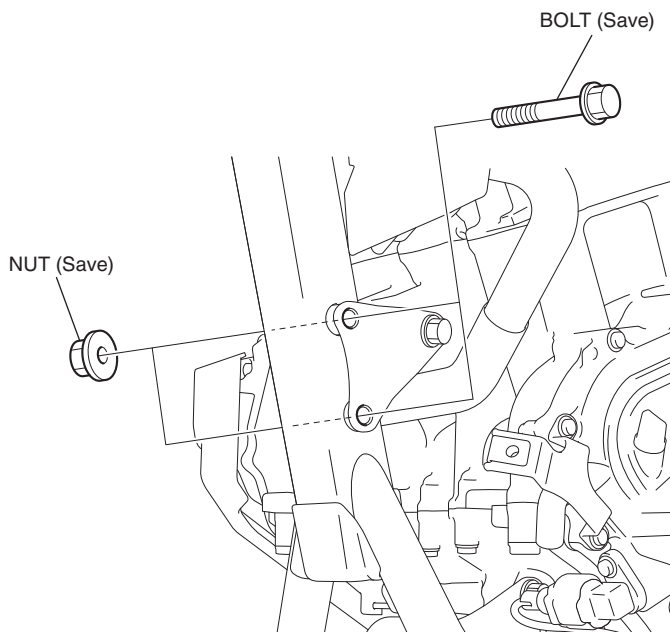
- Make sure that one person secures the lowered muffler, while the other installs the front side pipe.

Make sure that the cables are not burdened when the muffler is lowered.

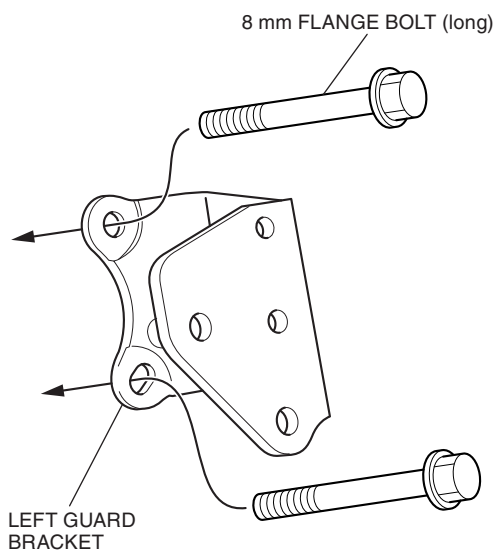


12. Remove the parts as shown.

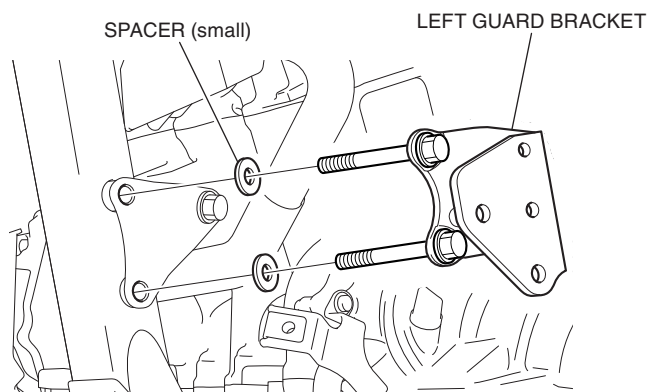


13. Insert the bolts as shown.



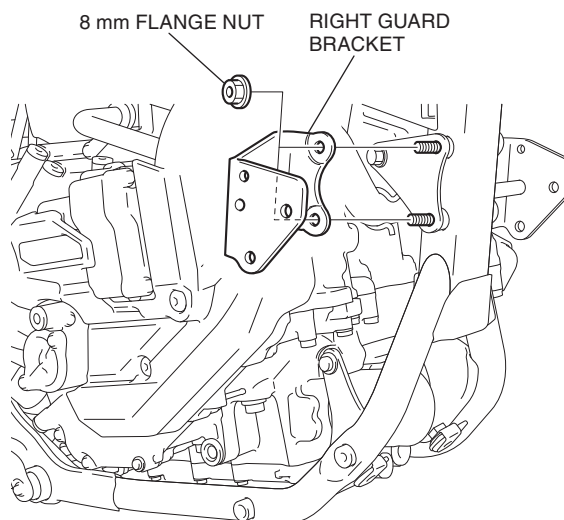
14. Install the left guard bracket as shown.

<Right side>

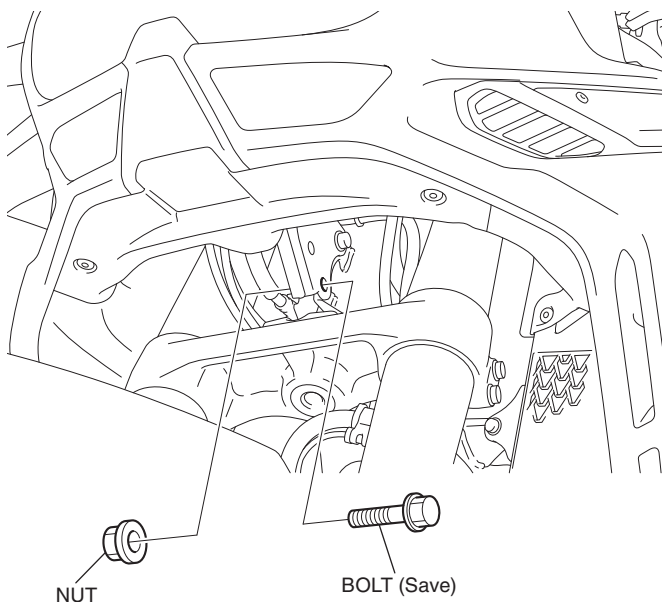


16. Install the muffler in the reverse order of removal.

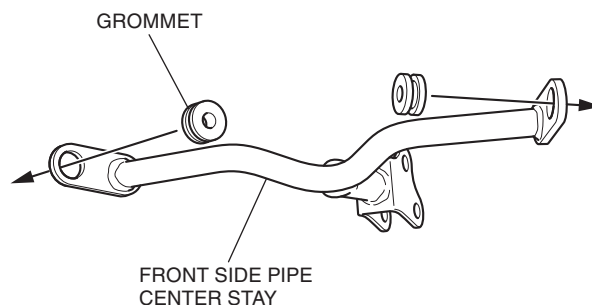
- **Always replace with a new gasket.**

17. Install the right and left middle cowl, drain tube and LAF sensor harness in the reverse order of removal.

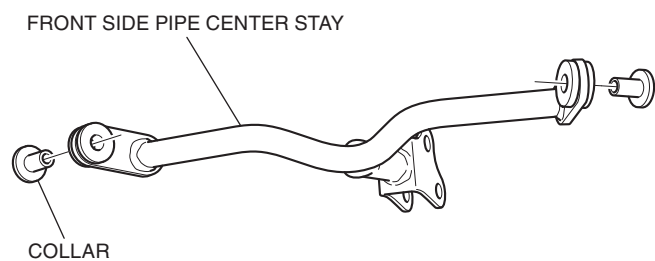
18. Remove the parts as shown.



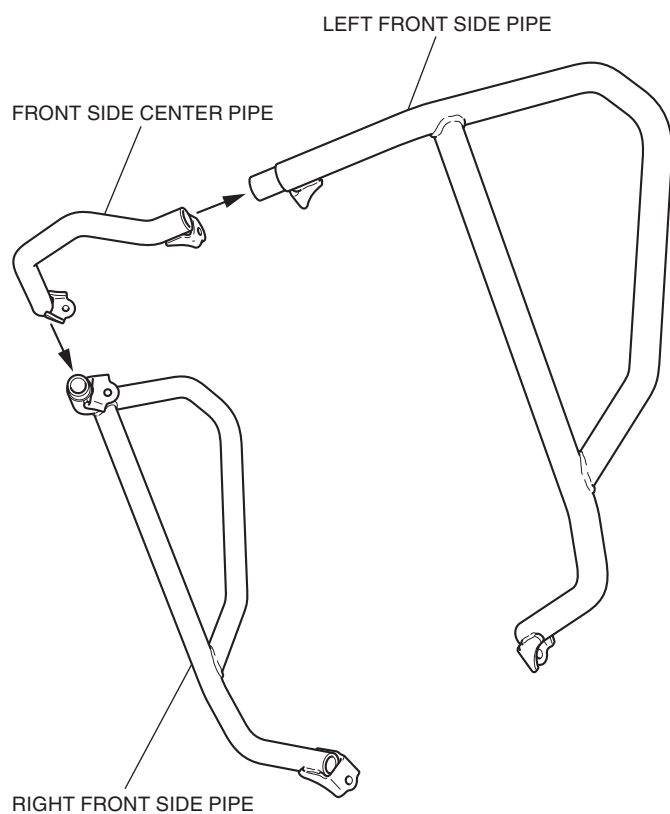
19. Install the grommets as shown.



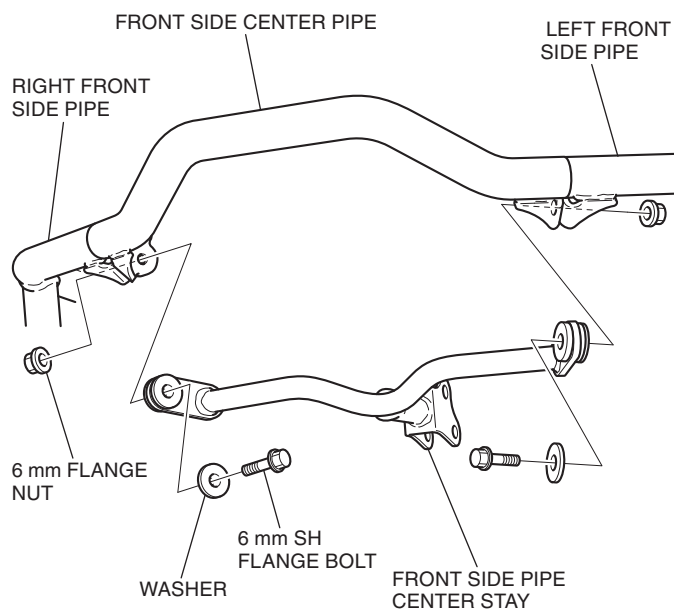
20. Install the collars to the front side pipe center stay as shown.



21. Install the front side center pipe as shown.



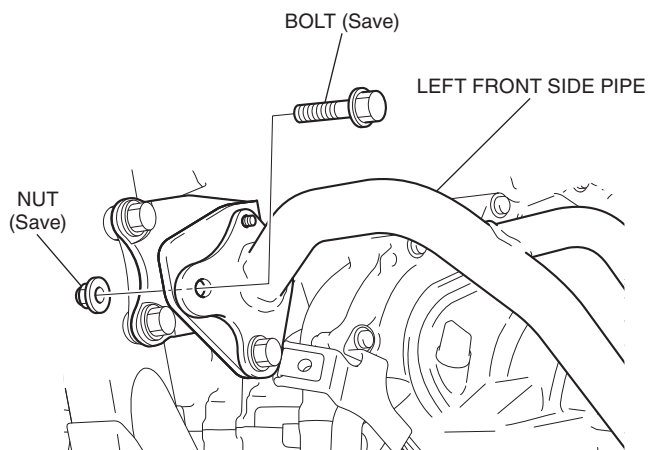
22. Loosely install the front side center stay as shown.

- Perform this step for the motorcycle equipped with the Engine Guard.
- Repeat on the right side.

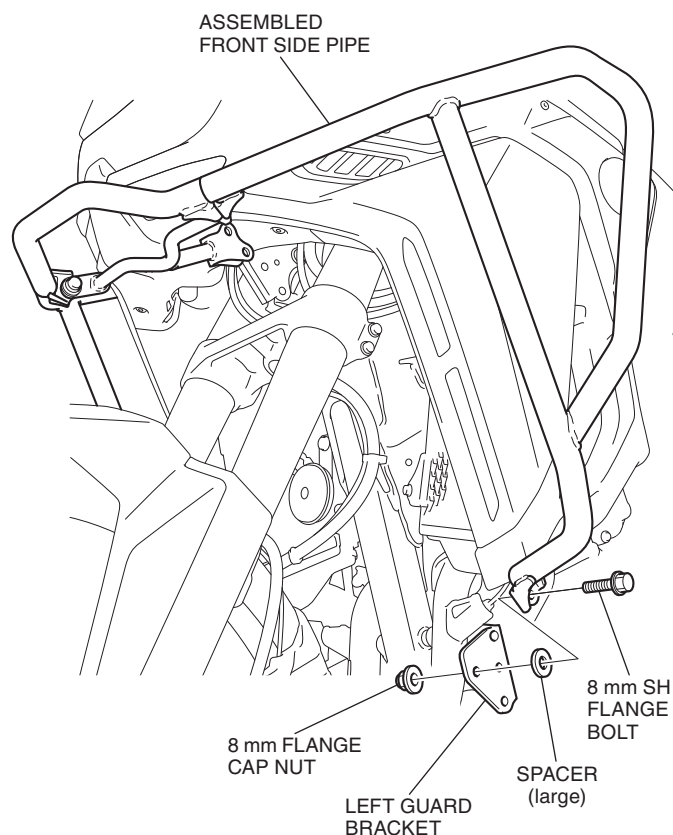

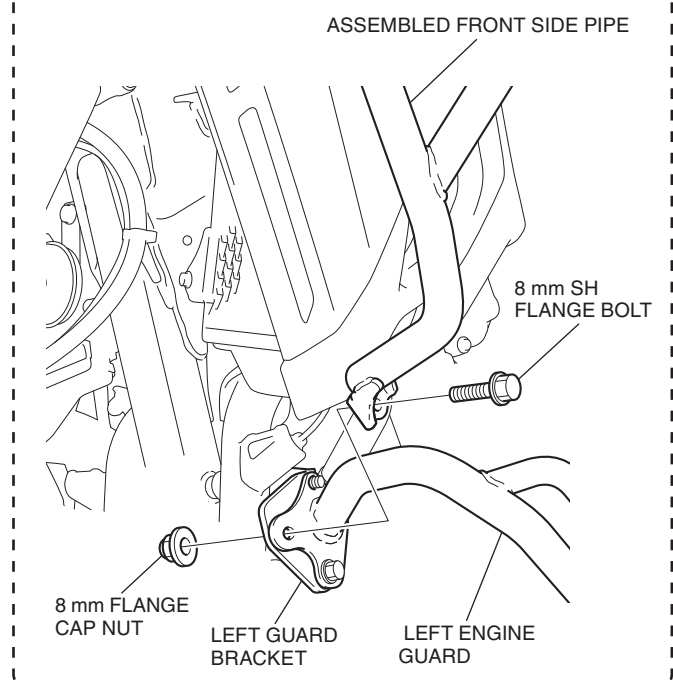
24. Loosely install the assembled front side pipe as shown.

- Repeat on the right side.

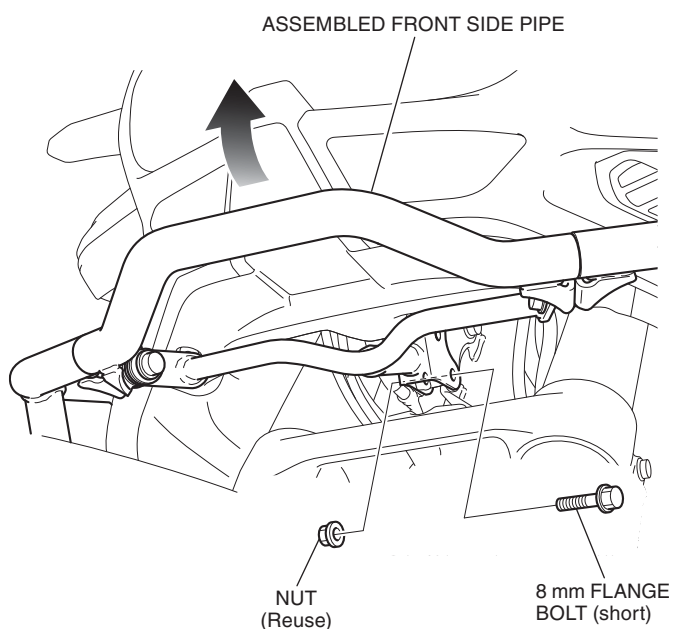
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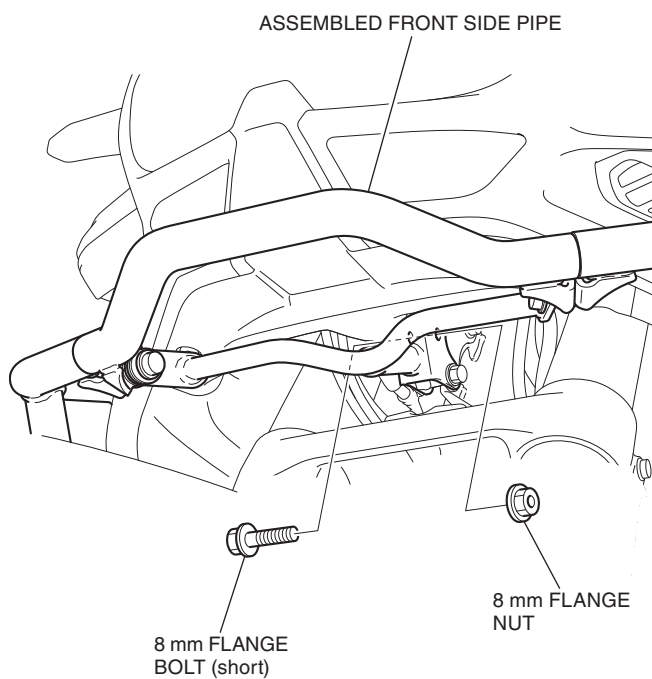
When installing the Engine Guard



25. Raise and install the assembled front side pipe as shown.



26. Install the parts as shown.



27. Tighten all loosely installed parts securely.

28. Install the motorcycle's parts in the reverse order of removal.

- Confirm that any wire harness is not caught or too tight.
