
RIDER FRIENDLY FEATURES




ZIPPER KEEPER

Secure zipper by inserting pull into zipper keeper loop, holding the zipper closed and preventing the pull from rubbing on tank.



HIDDEN POCKET

Store travel documents securely in hidden pocket on underside of Tank Bag.



MOVEABLE DIVIDER

Use elastic sleeves and loop on inner divider to organize credit cards, phone, pressure gauge, pen, etc.

PACKING TIPS

TANK BAG CARE

- Do not overstuff or over-load Tank Bag. The challenge should be to pack as little as necessary to be safe, comfortable and self-sufficient. Go light. Go fast. Go far.
- Pack all sharp and/or hard items inside a protective layer. For example, create a sleeve for tire irons

from a section of old inner tuber, pack tools in rolls

and wrap other hard items in clothing.

- Treat zippers with care and respect. Keep them clean and lubricated with zipper wax or lube.
 Don't yank or pull - take an extra second to make sure both zipper sides are aligned.
- Keep all webbing away from hot exhaust.
- Avoid sharp metal edges. Protect webbing with inner tube sleeve to prevent abrasion.
- Secure loose webbing ends when riding. Check and retighten all connections at each stop.

- Avoid exposure to insect repellants containing DEET.
- Hand wash Tank Bag with mild soap (like Simple Green), rinse with clean water and air dry. DO NOT MACHINE WASH OR DRY.
- Prevent mold, mildew and funky stench by unpacking wet gear, rinsing thoroughly with fresh water and airing dry.

Prevent scuffing or marks on your body work side or plastics with Giant Loop's Vinyl Protective Film. Even a single ride can buff the shine off your gloss coat. Take the time to protect your bike now!





MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS FANDANGO/DIABLO TANK BAG™



THESE INSTRUCTIONS ARE


GENERALIZED for Dual Sport/Enduro Bikes. Mounting points where webbing is secured vary with every make and model of motorcycle. Take a few minutes to familiarize yourself with the Tank Bag and how it will mount to your motorcycle. Remove tank bag from harness, allowing you to see the tailored shape and to become familiar with the harness' fit on your machine.





ADVENTURE BIKES

On some adventure touring motorcycles, engine guards and alternative mounting points may be used. On some makes/models, get the best fit by removing seat and thread webbing around frame rails. Replace seat, then tighten straps.




Thread the forward webbing under the frame head tube behind the steering stops and back into the thumb-lock buckle on harness. Adjust the front mount point to fix the front/back position of the harness to provide fuel fill access and full swing of the handlebars.

Do not damage or interfere with any wiring, cables, other controls.


Locate the appropriate connection points on each side of frame. Use the farthest forward positions available (i.e., the shortest distance). Loop each side's webbing straps around frame/subframe and back up through reflective tabs and thumb-lock buckles.

DO NOT allow webbing to contact exhaust! Tighten all three points of contact and secure all loose webbing ends using elastic loops on harness.



The Tank Bag is designed to allow easy access to your fuel filler by simply unzipping the bag to the corner and allowing it to hinge out of the way. Note that the concave shape of the Tank Bag's front allows vent tubes to breathe.

Unzip the Tank Bag completely to remove it from the harness and take it with you, leaving the harness mounted and ready to go.




ELECTRONICS PASS-THROUGH





Access the interior: Thread power cable through opening on front of Tank Bag.



Using the mesh pocket: Access mesh pocket under lid by threading through either side of sleeve at the base of the pocket.



Access the clear pocket lid:

To access clear top pocket, pass cable through zipper on underside of lid.
