



USE AND CARE INFORMATION


- · Check the accessory mounts frequently.
- The combined weight of the cargo and accessories must not exceed the maximum weight capacity of the trunk:

CB Radio Kit	15.4 lbs (7.0 kg)
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
INSTALLATION

NOTE:


- CB antenna (08E74-MCA-S40 or 08E96-MCA-100C) is required for installation of this accessory.
- · Install the CB antenna first.
- Disconnect the negative (-) cable from the battery before installing this accessory.
- After turning the ignition switch OFF, wait more than 10 seconds and then remove the negative cable of the battery.
- The memories of the tripmeter, clock, and suspension system will be erased when you disconnect the battery.
 Reset the clock and suspension after reconnecting the battery.
- Heat the bonding surfaces with a hair dryer if the ambient air temperature is below 70°F (21°C).
- The adhesive reaches full strength in 72 hours. Wait at least 24 hours before riding your motorcycle.
- 1. Install the CB antenna.
- Remove the audio unit as shown.




3. Mark the harnesses at the points shown below.




4. Match the marks and bundle the harnesses with cushion tape at the marked area.






5. Wind the second cushion tape around the first as shown.




6. Attach the CB radio in the position shown.

CB RADIO Remove the adhesive backing before attaching.




7. Route the CB antenna harness and CB power harness as shown.




8. Connect the CB power harness as shown.



9. Connect the CB antenna harness as shown.



- 10. Install the audio unit in the reverse order of removal.
- 11. Connect the CB controller harness to the audio unit as shown.



- 12. Reconnect the negative (-) battery cable and test the operation of the CB radio and audio unit.
- 13. Install the motorcycle's parts in the reverse order of removal.
