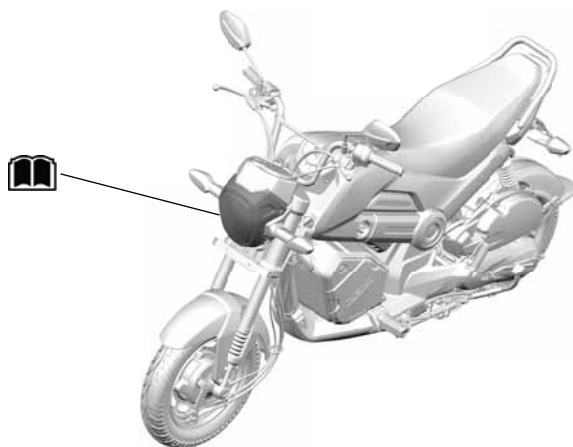

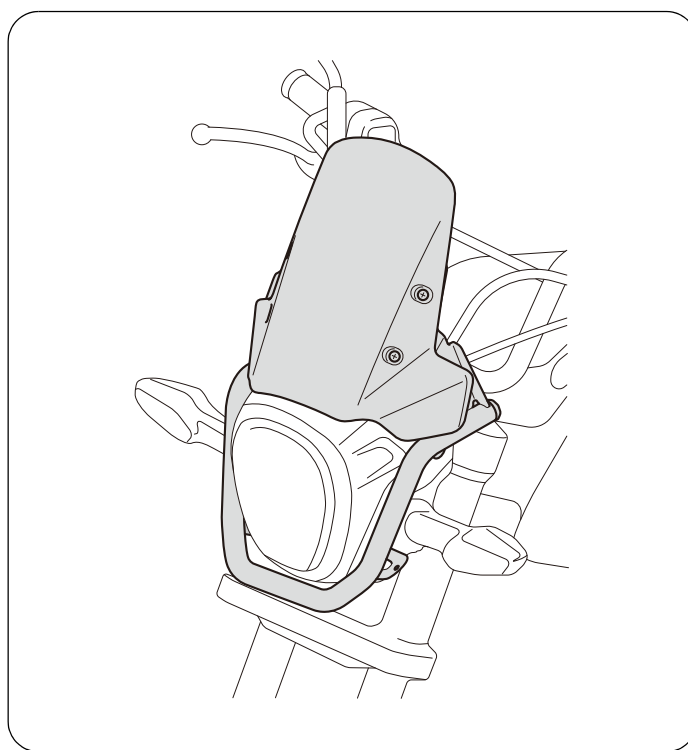

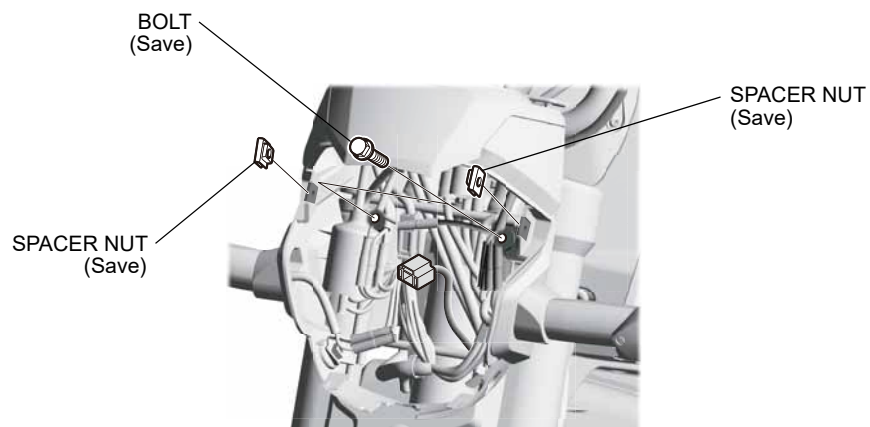
1. Refer to the Service Manual for the motorcycle, remove the motorcycle parts as shown.



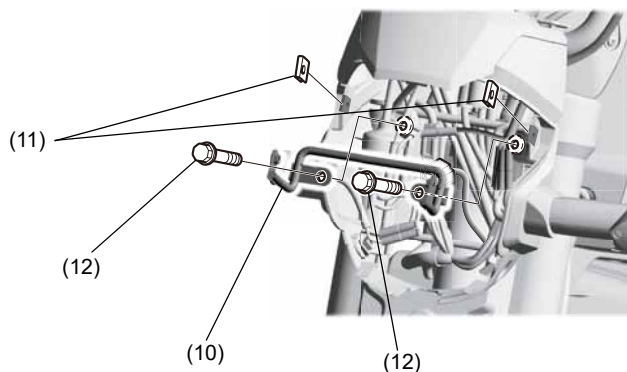
INSTALLED IMAGE



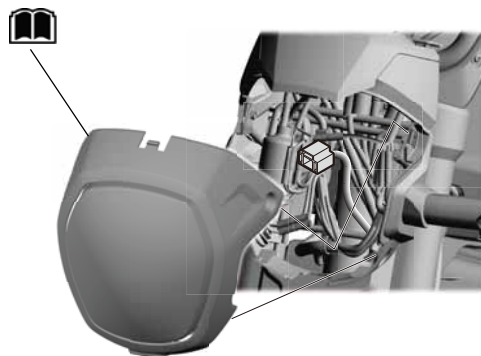
2. Remove as shown.



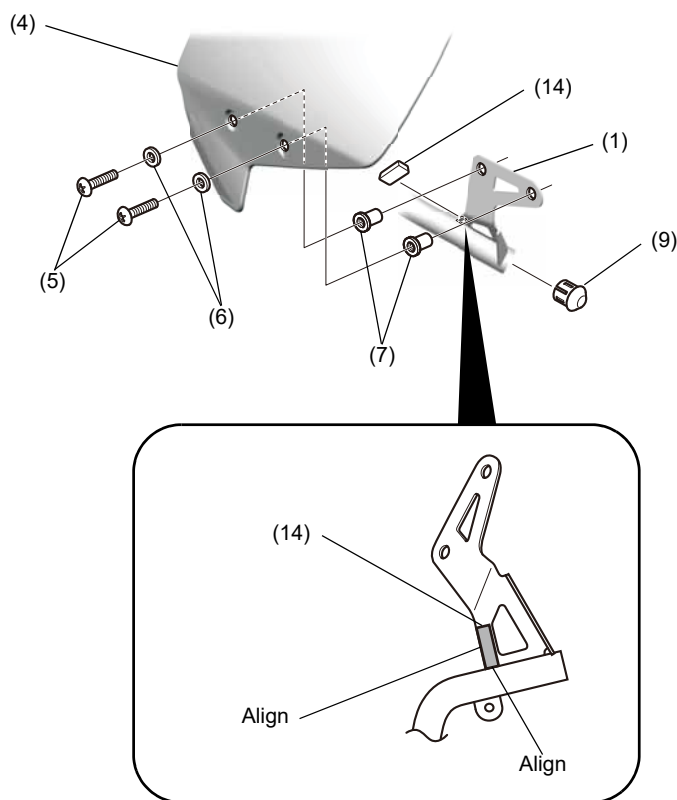
3. Install as shown.
